

## NOTES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF EDGE MARKER POSTS

### 1. GENERAL

These notes are for the guidance of Supervising Officers only and must not be included in the contract documents.

### 2. REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Supervising staff should note that the standard for edge delineation has been revised and is specified in TNZ General Circular 91/3 of 25 January 1991.
- 2.2 Anchoring is extremely important for heavy posts such as "Superflexo posts" and also for posts placed in areas where they are likely to be impacted or deflected regularly.
- 2.3 This specification requires use of the 450 x 40 white reflector as a consequence of using the current version of M/14.
- 2.4 Where significant lengths of posts are in near new condition consideration should be given to deleting requirements for new reflectors and repaint on reused posts.
- 2.5 Posts fitted with type approved barb retaining anchorages shall be installed in a manner which ensures that the barb engages with the surroundings ground and functions to prevent the post from being pulled vertically by hand from the ground.

### 3. POST MATERIAL

In accordance with current TNZ policy unless relocation within the contract is involved use of wooden posts is not permitted.
